Statement of faith

The Wildflower Centre will be an independent non-profit organisation as part of the overall vision of Manna Theatre Company, spearheaded and run by Arialle Crick.


This will be run on a self-employed business basis with a non-for-profit structure.

Departments

What kind of activities does the Wildflower Centre provide?

Arts and creative outlets may be helpful for those who find it difficult to put their thoughts and feelings into words. They may also help with addressing painful feelings or experiences, including those of trauma. Some people find that doing a creative activity helps put them at ease and can make it feel less intense. All class are applicable to disabled users and wheelchair access will be provided.

The Wildflower Centre will provide activities in the following areas.

Dance workshop

Dance Movement

This involves using body movement and dance. For example, you might explore different types of movements and rhythms. To express and create dances, dance creates a sense of confidence and exploring working as a team in expression helps to create a balance of mind and body awareness.



Drama

Drama involves using different types of drama and performance activities. For example, participants might invent characters, tell stories, play game, do mimes, and use puppets, masks or other objects. Not all activities will involve talking. Acting skills or experience are not needed. Drama classes has as its focus, the intentional use of healing aspects of drama and theatre. It is a method of working and playing that uses action methods to facilitate creativity, imagination, learning, insight and growth.

- **4** Express or resolve difficult thought or feelings
- ♣ Safely explore being playful and using their imagination
- **♣** Explore how mental health problems affect their body.

At the Wildflower Centre, Drama runs with the overall vision of the Dwelling which is a place that uses the arts to bring the Christian faith alive and this will be a main area of the Wildflower centre.

Music

You don't need to have any musical knowledge or experience to use music as a way of health – for example, you don't need to know how to play any instruments, read music or be a good singer.

Some people find that music helps them to:

- **4** Communicate difficult thoughts or feelings.
- **4** Express themselves in new ways.

Our aim is to find volunteers that can offer activities around instruments and music to encourage creation of new pieces and to express through music and voice

Visual art

Visual art involves using visual art materials.



For example, pens, pencils, crayons, paint, chalk, clay or collaging may be used. Another option is to use digital media, such as photos or video. No prior art skills or experience is needed. With support from our team art materials are used to help participants express their creativity and make pieces to be proud of

Gardening and growing and small holding animal care

At the wildflower centre is to create spaces, as structured gardens where people can learn about various plants and flowers, help with the culture and growing of both plants and wildflowers and to learn to grow food and look after a small selection of animals such as chickens, goats and sheep.

Working alongside our grounds team, opportunities for young and older generations to help keep the centre running.

Safeguarding & Staff Training


The Wildflower Centre is committed to ensuring the safety of everyone we support and people who visit our places.




Marketing Analysis

Demographical area of the centre

The West Midlands particularly the West Bromwich area, is one of the most underprivileged areas in the UK.

We aim to provide a place out of the city that serves this area within a 30-minute travel of this area.

Competitor analysis

Wildflower is a unique organisation in several different ways mainly due to our in-person availability and practical and organised courses whilst keeping our focus on Christ.

In research of similar faith organisations, the results found showed that the vast majority that offer counselling and therapy do so through online services, whilst those that had an in-person presence, were retreats that allowed others to bring training to their premises.

One thing that stood out in the research, was the low online visibility of this sector, which the Wildflower intends to address in the company's marketing approach.

Funding needed and for what purpose

- ♣Purchase of Land by Manna Theatre company to the site of minimal 2 acres
- ♣ Mains water and electricity to be installed on the site for Manna Theatre Company unless present already

Planning permission sort for use of Land for the above purposes.



Pre-launch tasks:

- **♣** Investigate any council restrictions.
- ♣ Produce architectural drawings for all phases of development.
- ♣ Plan access route & parking facilities.

- **♣** Select and invite accountability board
- **4** Start marketing with advertising banners and leaflets at churches and rehab centres.
- ♣ Source team through recruitment process via Manna Theatre company.
- ♣ Start therapy/ counselling classes/workshops offsite in local church hall/rooms.

Funding & support.

The Wildflower Centre plans on funding the phases by applying for various grants across the phases. In addition, it is anticipated that the centre will form partnerships with individuals and local churches. This in turn will generate individual donations.
